Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that council call tenders for 10,000 tons of $\frac{5}{8}$ " crushed gravel to be crushed, delivered and spread on Township roads, not later than September first 1963. Also state prices for stockpiling.

Moved by St. Pilgrim, seconded by R. Catter that the vote for Victoria Hospital by-law be called for May 4th 1963 at the various polling divisions between the hours of 11.00 A.M. and 7.00 P.M. local time.

Council then adjourned and the next regular council meeting to be held on Wednesday evening May 1st 1963 at 8.00 P.M.

Forsters Falls, May 1st, 1963

Ross Municipal Council met in their regular monthly meeting with all members present.

Minutes of last two meetings were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve and the correspondence and accounts were read and considered.

It was moved by Geo. Olmstead and seconded by St. Pilgrim that council accept the tender of Smith's Construction Co. Ltd of Annapolis for crushed gravel for the year 1963 as follows: Hauling, crushing and spreading on township roads at a price of .97¢ per ton and .55¢ per ton for stockpiling, subject to approval of Dept of Highways.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by St. Pilgrim that council accept the tender of Barker Motors, Ltd. of Ross for three ton truck for the township at a price of \$5,088.20, subject to the approval of the Department of Highways.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 4 for the month of April 1963 in the amount of 2,994.81

Moved by R. Catter, seconded by Wm. Stone that council pay the annual grant of \$50.00 to North Ross Agricultural Society for the year 1963
