Subject to the approval of the Municipal Board this one-way snow plough to be purchased by tender with the stipulation that it be paid for in January 1964.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council award the surplus snow ploughing for the 1963-64 season to Stafford M. Miller at a rate of \$8.00 per hour and a minimum for the season of \$700.00
