

Foresters Falls, Ont. December 2nd 1964

Ross Municipal Council met on above date with all members present

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council have the grader available to the public to snowplough lanes at a minimum charge of \$3.00 per trip or a rate of \$12.00 per hr. This arrangement has the sanction of the Department of Highways

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that council purchase the property formerly known as S. S. No. 1 Ross from Ross Township School Area No. 2 at a price of \$1.00 plus \$25.00 for the contents. All costs of this purchase to be charged back to the ratepayers of this section formerly known as S. S. No. 1 Ross.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council make a grant to the Halcy. Athletic Association in the amount of \$250.00 for the purpose of sponsoring sports in the Halcy area.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Cates that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 11 for the month of November in the amount of \$3,447.62.
