

Forrestus Falls, Ont. February 5th 1965

Ross Municipal Council met on above date with all members present. On account of other business requiring attention the meeting was postponed from Wednesday February 3rd as formerly scheduled to February 5th.

The minutes of the former meetings were read and adopted.

It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by G. Almetrad that council authorize a grant of \$250.00 to Ross Township Farmers Union, Local 335 for the purpose of financing Farm Union activities in the Township.

The regular road appropriation by-law allotted by the Department of Highways for the year 1965 in the amount of \$90,000.00 was accepted by the council.

It was moved by H. Pilgrim and seconded by Wm. Stone that council accept and pay Road Voucher No 1 for the month of January in the amount of \$2,429.38.
