

Forsters Falls Ont March 3d 1965

Pass Municipal Council met on above date with all members present.

The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted as read.

It was moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council become the purchasers of all properties on the tax sale list that do not bring the full price of taxes and interest against said properties.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council approve the payment of a grant in the amount of \$900.00 to Cobden Agricultural Society for the year 1965.

Moved by Alden May, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council become the purchasers of the school and lot in the Township formerly known as S. S. No. 1 Pass at a price for the school and lot of \$1.00 and the contents of school at a price of \$25.00 in accordance with agreement made by Pass Township School Area No. 2.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council rescind former by-law for collecting taxes being by-law No. 844 and that we revert to the original by-law whereby the collection of taxes be made once yearly with the due date for payment being December 20th 1965 with interest at the rate of 2% being unpaid on taxes being paid between December 21st 1965 to December 31st 1965 inclusive and $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% per month be charged on unpaid taxes after January 1st 1966 until paid.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 2 for the month of February 1965 in the amount of 3,827.99.
