

Foresters Falls, Ont. July 19th 1965

A special meeting of council was called on this date to consider by-law for the purpose of building of Council Chambers as a Centenary project and also to consider the application of Foresters Falls Institute for assistance in making a small park at the western end of the Village as a Centenary project.

It was moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council pass a by-law to approve the building of Council Chambers in Foresters Falls as a Centenary Project, the estimated cost of the land \$675.00 and buildings \$22,000.00.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council assist the Foresters Falls Women's Institute in making a small park at the western entrance of the Village as a Centennial Project. That we hire equipment to furnish ten to fifteen truck loads of fill and the necessary levelling with the equipment.

Ross Municipal Council met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meetings were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve.

A Delegation of ratepayers of the Township again met with the council in regard to the new proposed Composite School. Dissatisfaction was expressed with the project and the main objection seemed to centre around the proposed boundaries of the school. Considerable discussion was also voiced in regard to the cost and objection was raised about the Department's handling of school matters in general.

It was moved by Alden May and seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council accept & pay Road Voucher for July in the amount of \$10,772.70.

The following accounts were paid for payment: Ernest Ross, sheep killed by dogs \$60.00, William Hegart, sheep Valuator \$6.00, Robert Church, clearing dumps \$30.00, Stafford M. Miller, gas for spray truck \$7.46, Colden Sun, letterheads & envelopes \$35.45, Village of Colden, 2d db payment Colden High School \$5,522.88, Receiver General of Canada, unemp. ins. stamps \$22.56,

Moved by N. Pelgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that under the Highway Regulation Act for the purpose of Road Allowance in respect of County Road No. 21 be known as Cedar Hammock Park and to conform with the Regulation governing the paper signs.
