

Foresters Falls, Ont. Feb 2nd 1966

The regular monthly meeting of Pass Municipal Council met on above date with all members present:

The minutes of the last meetings were read and adopted as read.

It was moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council give their approval to an extension of Holy Cemetery in accordance with Section 7 of the Cemetery Act.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Alden May that council make the following appointments for the year 1966: Representative to Upper Ottawa Valley Travel Council: - George Olmstead; Trench Excavation Inspector: - Hawey Pilgrim, S.M.O. Representative: - Alden May

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council rescind former by-law No. 83⁶ respecting wages of Road Superintendent. By-law introduced by Geo. Olmstead and seconded by Alden May that the salary of the Road Superintendent effective from February 1st 1966 be now approved by council in the amount of \$370.00 per month from \$350.00 plus 10% per mile for use of car for road purposes to a maximum of \$500.00. Also, the wages of regular road employees be raised from \$1.50 per hr. to \$1.60 plus an additional 5% per hr. for grade operator during the months from May 1st to October 31st inclusive also plus 5% per hr. for Assistant Foreman when required. Beginners wages from \$1.35 to ^{\$1.50} ~~\$1.45~~ per hr. Above wage schedule also to be effective from February 1st 1966.

Moved by Alden May, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 1 for the month of January 1966 in the amount of \$4,760.10

On view of the expected absence of the Reeve for approximately three weeks it was moved by Geo. Olmstead and seconded by Alden May that William Stone act as Reeve (pro-tem) during his absence.
