Fauntleroy Falls, Ont. May 17th 1966

A special meeting of council was called on this date to discuss matters of proposed road paving with Mr Alex J. Graham and to discuss the matter of passing a by to change the date of the first payment of taxes.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Alden May that council proceed with plans to prepare and double surface treat approximately 4.9 miles of township roads and reconstruct approximately 1.5 miles of road at an estimated cost of \$700,000.00 with Alex J. Graham as Consultant Engineer. Roads are as follows: - Lake Road 2.3 miles, Government Road 2.0 miles, Grants Settlement Road 0.6 miles, Fourth Line Road 1.5 miles.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by N. Pilgrim that council revoke by law No 880 to change the date of the payment of the first instalment of taxes from the 30th day of June 1966 and that this date now be changed to the 30th day of July 1966. The second instalment ^{payment} to remain the same December 20th 1966
