Road Employees: Grader Operator \$1.85 per hour, plus 10¢ per hour from April 1st to October 31st.

Regular Employees: \$1.85 per hour, plus 10¢ per hr. for Assistant Foreman when required

Experienced part time employees \$1.75 per hr.

Starting wages \$1.65 per hour.

Moved by St. Pilgrim, seconded by Leo Pathwell that Council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 10 for the month of October in the amount of \$13,507.22.
