Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council call tenders for wire, steel posts, staples, brace wire and wooden posts for Township purposes for 1968. Also culverts. Material to be stored and be picked up when required at the convenience of the Road Superintendent

Notice was received from the Province that they are discontinuing the paying of fox bounty effective February 29th 1968. The County will pay \$500 and it was moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Clarence Bilson that the council pay one dollar per fox thus making a total of \$400 per fox as formerly.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that council accept the tender of Herbert E. Brumm for supplying, crushing, hauling and spreading of <sup>10,000 tons</sup>  $\frac{5}{8}$ " crushed gravel for maintenance work to be completed by June 15th 1968 at a price of \$1.17 per ton. Also 10,000 tons of  $\frac{5}{8}$ " crushed gravel to be spread on construction roads at a later date for \$1.17 per ton. Stockpiling at 70¢ per ton, subject to the approval of the Department of Highways. Another tender was received from Gady & Graham, Construction Co. of Kinburn, Ont at a price of \$1.32 for first job \$1.32 for second job at a later date and stockpiling .86¢.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by G. Olmstead that council authorize the Ontario Fire Marshall's office to make a survey of the Township of Ross for a study of the needs of the Township for fire fighting equipment.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Leo Rathwell that that council accept and authorize the paying of Road Voucher No. 3 for the month of March in the amount of \$11,863.96.
