

Foresters Falls, Ont. May 1st 1968

The regular monthly meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held on above date with all members present.

The minutes of former meeting were read and adopted.

It was moved by C. Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that council accept the tender of Caletton Culvert Co. Ltd for the supplying of culvert requirements to the Township for the year 1968.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council accept the tender of Raymond Bell for the supplying of fencing requirements for the year 1968 as follows: - 8-42 wire \$1.30 per rod, seven ft. steel posts \$1.07 including ties, 16' gates \$25.50, No. 9 galv. brace wire \$3.80 per cut, staples 50 lb \$6.75, Cedar posts peeled 8' long 6" top .75 & 9' long 8" top .90 & 12' long 4" top .75 &.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead that council call tenders for drilling and blasting of approximately 3,500 cubic yards of rock on No. 1 side road in the Township of Ross. Work to be completed on or before July 15th 1968. Further information to be received from the Road Superintendent.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council approve the purchase of additional land for cemetery to the Ross Presbyterian Cemetery.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 4 for the month of April in the amount of \$4,081.38.

 requesting a grant to assist in building a vault in the  
 Cobden Cemetery of which Ross Township would be entitled to  
 use it if required.

For this purpose it was moved by Geo. Olmstead,  
 seconded by H. Pilgrim that council approve the payment of  
 a grant of \$1,000.00 to the Cobden Cemetery Committee for the  
 purpose of assisting in the building of a vault in the  
 Cobden cemetery and the residents of Ross Township be entitled  
 to its use if required. Cobden to grant the same amount or more.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell  
 that council pay the former debenture payment for 1967 to  
 The Village of Eganville for the Cobden-Eganville District High  
 School plus interest at the rate of 6% from June 1st 1967.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that  
 council approve the purchase of three acres of land from Gibbons  
 Bros. for a dump site for the Halcy Area at a price of Six Hundred Dollars.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council instruct  
 the Clerk to consult Mr. Laidly in regard to the proper means for the paying  
 of the Opeongo High School levy for 1967 and to pay it if and when required.

Meeting was then adjourned and the next regular council meeting to be  
 held on Wednesday evening at Forsters Falls on June 5th 1968 at 8:00 p.m.
