

Foresters Falls, Ont. October 3d. 1968

This amount was paid to the Canadian Legion at Cobden for this purpose.

The meeting was then adjourned and the next regular council meeting to be held on Wednesday evening, November 6th at Foresters Falls at 8.00 P.M.
