

Forsters Falls, Ont. October 1st 1969

The regular monthly meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held on this date with all members present.

The minutes of the last two meetings were read and adopted by council.

It was moved by St. Pilgrim, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council make application to the Department of Highways for interim payment of subsidy on Road by-law for the year 1969.

Moved by George Almstead, seconded by St. Pilgrim that Council pay the full amount of the 1969 levy to the Renfrew County Separate School Board.

Moved by George Almstead, seconded by Clarence Wilson that Council purchase a wreath at the price of ten dollars to be placed on the cenotaph at Colden on Remembrance Day, November 11th, 1969 if and when requested and that Harvey Pilgrim be appointed for the placing of the wreath.

Moved by George Almstead, seconded by St. Pilgrim that Council accept and pay Road Voucher no. 9 for the month of September in the amount of \$4,407.27.
