

Forsters Falls, Ont. January 28th 1970

A special meeting of Council was held on above date to discuss wage schedule for township labourers.

It was moved by George Olmstead, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council approve an increase in the Road Superintendent's salary from \$5,650.00 per year to \$6,475.00 per year with sick leave benefits and a rate of 10¢ per mile for travelling expenses while on road duty. A by-law to be passed to this effect, subject to the approval of the Department of Highways.

Moved by Clarence Wilson, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council approve an increase in Township Employees wages of 30¢ per hr., retroactive to January 1st 1970, and that employees also be given sick leave benefit at the rate of 1½ days per calendar month up to a maximum of 200 working days. The sick leave benefits may be used as needed or may be cashed in at retirement or on the termination of work by the employee. The schedule of wages now is as follows:-

Permanent Labour \$2.27 per hr.

Tractor & Truck Operator \$2.42 per hr.

Grader Operator from April 1st to October 31st. \$2.52 per hr.

Casual Labour \$2.12 per hr.

Assistant Road Foreman when required 10¢ per hr. extra.

Moved by Geo Olmstead, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council rescind former motion in respect to rate for snowplowing streets to raise the former rate in the Haly Area from \$5.00 per hr. to \$6.00 and the rate for clearing and sanding streets at Forsters Falls at \$5.00 per hour.

Moved by Clarence Bileon, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council become the purchaser of properties on the tax sale for 1969 that do not bring the full amount of the taxes and costs of same.

It was decided to establish a Collection Depot for unused supplies of D.D.T. as requested by the County Health Unit. For this purpose it was decided to use the Municipal Hall at Forsters Falls for a Collection Unit and that February 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>, 1970 between the hours of 9.00 A.M. and 6.00 P.M. it be made available for same.

Meeting was then adjourned. Next meeting March 4<sup>th</sup>, 1970 at 8.00 P.M.
