Pilgrim, seconded by Clarence Bilson that Council call for tenders for the following fencing requirements for the year 1970:- Approximately 2,400 rods 8 strand wire, No. 842, even spacing, 900 cedar posts 6" tops 8' long, peeled, 300 cedar posts 8" tops 8' long, peeled, 100 cedar brace posts 4" tops 12' long peeled, 1200 steel posts 7' long, 400 lbs. brace wire, 100 lbs staples, 22 wire gates 16' long.
