Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Leo Rathwell that a refund of overpaid taxes be made to the following ratepayers: Henry Browne, Joseph Uzina, Donald Rathwell & Donald Whillans.

Moved by George Olmstead, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Reginald Humphris having been overcharged for business assessment while at Down's Supermarket Service Station at Halyx that Council authorize that the amount he was overcharged be cancelled as follows: 7 months in 1968 in the amount of \$37.48, 12 months in 1969 in the amount of \$99.68.
