

Foresters Falls, Ont. June 9th 1970.

A special meeting of Council was held in the United Church basement at Halcy on above date with the ratepayers concerned in the proposed drainage project in the Halcy area as a Court of Revision.

Mr. Morrison of the Engineering firm of Graham, Berman & Associates, Ltd. of Ottawa was present and conducted the meeting.

It was moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Harvey Pilgrim that the meeting is now open to hear any appeals against <sup>the</sup> assessment of the proposed Halcy Drainage Project as submitted by the Engineers in charge. One appeal was received and the Court of Revision sustained the assessment.

At this meeting also, the matter of the sale of the old fire truck at Halcy was brought up. A request had been received from the Mayor of Portage du Fort, Que. asking our Council to state what price we would want for it. In answer, the following Resolution was passed:-

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Pathwell that Council agree to sell the present Halcy Fire Truck to the Village of Portage du Fort, Que. for the sum of \$350.00. Truck to be sold as is when our new fire truck is received in Halcy.
