

Foresters Falls, Ont. July 15th, 1970

A special meeting of Council was held on this date to consider tenders for drainage, Consider a by-law for licencing of lotteries, rates and the selling of a Village lot.

Mr. Morrison of the Firm of Graham, Berman & Associates, Engineers of Ottawa was present to consider tenders for Drainage Project at Haly. No tenders were received in response to our tender call and Mr. Morrison informed Council he would endeavour to procure some firm to do the job as soon as possible.

A by-law was passed on Motion of George Olmstead and seconded by St. Belgrin for the purpose of authorizing the licencing of lotteries for charitable and religious purposes, and the charging of fees for such licences, subject to the approval of the Minister of Financial and Commercial Affairs.

Moved by Leo Rathwell, seconded by Clarence Bilton that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of accepting the rates for taxation purposes for 1970 as presented by Mr. Melskie, Representative from the Department of Municipal Affairs as follows:-

General Purposes Res. 20.1 mills, Comm. 25.9 mills.  
 Public School Res. 15.0 mills, Comm 16.7 mills.  
 High School Res. 16.7 mills, Comm 18.6 mills.  
 County Rates Res. 14.9 mills, Comm. 14.9 "  
 Street Lights 3.5 mills  
 Fed. of Agr .2 mills.

Moved by George Olmstead, seconded by St. Belgrin that Council approve the selling of Lot No. V.d. 67, concession 8 owned by the Township in the Village of Foresters Falls to Fred Pass for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) plus expenses.

Moved by Clarence Bilton, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council authorize Mr. Mc Nab, the Township Solicitor to take action to endeavour to collect the last payment of taxes for 1969 from Haly Industries, Ltd. of Haly, Ont.

Meeting was then adjourned.
