

Forsters Falls, Ont. October 7th 1970

Ross Municipal Council met in their regular monthly meeting on above date with all members present.

It was moved by G. Olmstead, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council approve the passing of a by-law for the purpose of naming a date and place for a Nominations meeting for the purpose of nominating a candidate for the office of Trustee for Renfrew County School Board for the term 1971-72. The meeting to be held on November 23^d 1970 between the hours of 8.00 P.M. and 9.00 p.m. in the Orange Hall at Forsters. Should an election be necessary, it is to be held in the various polling places of the municipalities concerned, being the Village of Cobden and the Townships of Bromley and Ross, on December 7th 1970 between the hours of 10.00 A.M. and 8.00 P.M.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Clarence Bilson that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of nominations for the office of Reeve and Councillors for the term 1971-72 to be held in the Orange Hall at Forsters Falls on November 26th 1970 between the hours of 8.00 p.m. and 9 p.m. Should an election be necessary, it is to be held in the various polling places of the municipality on December 7th 1970 between the hours of 10.00 A.M. and 8.00 p.m.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council approve the payment of \$30.00 to the Librarian as a petty cash fund for use in small purchases.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council authorize Ray Dittburner, Fire Chief to purchase 500 feet of 1½ in. fire hose and also two fog nozzles for 1½ inch hose.
