

Forsters Falls, Ont. March 5th 1971

The balance of regular meeting was resumed on this date and all members were present.

It was moved by St. Pilgrim, seconded by George Olmstead that Council call for gravel tenders for supplying, crushing, hauling and spreading approximately 10,000 tons of gravel to pass through $\frac{5}{8}$ " screen, not more than 45% fines on township roads. Work to be completed on or before June 30th 1971. Also, 15,000 tons more or less of same as above, work to be done at a later date. Contract must strip all pits where necessary. Work to be done under the supervision of the Road Superintendent and subject to the approval of the Department of Highways.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council rescind former Resolution dated February 4th 1971 which called ~~call~~ for tenders for truck with 1 way plow and now to read a V plow. The Resolution now calls for a 5 ton Truck Chassis, cab and dump-box - 84 in. C.A. Standard, with V-Plow and a 12 ft. levelling wing.

Moved by Clarence Bilson ^{seconded by Leo Rathwell} that Council pass a by-law agreeing that Pass Township participate in the Penfrew County Agricultural Veterinarian Unit and our assessment to be based on the 1966 census of cattle for Pass Township which was 7,217 head @ 5¢ per head resulting in \$360.85 for the year.

Moved by St. Pilgrim, seconded by George Olmstead that Council approve a grant of \$50.00 to the North Penfrew Agricultural Society for the year 1971.

The following accounts were passed and paid at this meeting: - Penfrew County Agricultural Veterinarian Unit \$360.85, North Penfrew Agricultural Society, grant \$50.00.

Meeting was then adjourned and the next regular meeting to be held on Wednesday evening, April 7th at Forsters Falls at 8.00 p.m.
