

Foresters Falls, Ont. May 13th 1971

A special meeting of Council was called on this date to consider a letter from B. G. Watt requesting that we endorse his efforts to establish Pine Ridge Park and Marina & Lumber, Ltd. and to consider making remuneration to the enumerators of population census to enumerate the dogs in the municipality in connection with their duties.

It was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Clarence Bilson that Council approve in principle and hereby endorse the earnest efforts of Mr. B. G. Watt and Pine Ridge Lumber, Ltd. to promote Pine Ridge Park and Marina Lumber, Ltd. in the best interests of the people of the County and that the Planning Board consider that the establishment of Pine Ridge Park and Marina & Lumber Ltd. will be to the benefit to the people of the County and to Tourism in the Ottawa Valley generally.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council authorize the person or persons making the enumeration of the population census in the Township for the year 1971 to:-

(1) Register the dogs of the property owners in the Township and the Enumerator shall receive a fee from the municipality of 20 cents per dog.

(2) Collect the dog tax, if possible, of the tenants dogs in the Township and the Enumerator shall receive 50 cents for each tenants dog tax collected.

The dog tax on a male dog or spayed female shall be \$2.00.

The dog tax on a female dog shall be \$4.00.

A charge of \$4.00 dog tax shall be imposed on each additional dog after the first.

Meeting was then adjourned.
