Ross Municipal Council met in their regular ^{monthly} meeting on above date with all members present.

The minutes of former meetings were read and adopted by Council.

It was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by G. Olmstead that Council approve a rate for burial of indigent patients in the Township of Ross at Four Hundred Dollars

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 8 for the Month of August in the amount of \$21,453.00.

The meeting was adjourned, but owing to the heavy agenda for this meeting, the balance of meeting was postponed until the next evening.

At this meeting it was moved by George Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council approve a Supplementary by-law to apply to the Department of Transportation & Communications for assistance for winter control occasioned by the excessive fall of snow in the 1971 season as compared with the 1970 season in the amount of \$5,838.39.

Recommended fire insurance raises were received from Leslie Collins and on motion of Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council approve the recommended increases in the fire insurance policy with the exception of the Women's Institute Hall and contents of same being owned by the Township.
