Bisson Construction, Ltd. of Hull, Quebec in the amount of \$7,835.00 for the construction of the Forsters Falls Municipal Drain in accordance with the specifications for same. Work to be completed prior before November 30th 1971. Another tender was received from Mackenzie & Son of Pembroke at a price of 20,868.00.
