A special meeting called on above date to consider the Road Appropriation by-law for 1972. A letter was received from the Department of Transportation & Communications at Ottawa whereby an allotment for subsidy was presented as follows: - Construction \$47,800.00, Maintenance \$20,700.00.

It was moved by Clarence Bilson seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council accept the foregoing allocation resulting in corresponding expenditures of \$84,636.36 for Construction and \$37,068.18 for Maintenance a total of \$121,704.54.

The meeting was then adjourned.

Foresters Falls, Ont. March 9th 1972

A special meeting was called on this date to consider wages for Township employees, fencing materials and gravel tenders.

It was moved by George Olmstead, seconded by St. Pilgrim that Council approve the following wages for Township employees for the year 1972 retroactive to January 1st 1972: -

Starting rate \$2.57 per hr.

Permanent rate \$2.72 per hr.

Tractor and Truck Operator \$2.87 per hr.

Grader Operator \$2.97 per hr. from April 1st to October 31st.

Road Superintendent salary \$7,500.00 plus 10 cents per mile for travelling expenses while on road duty, subject to the approval of the Department of Transportation and Communications. Assistant Road Foreman 10 cents per hr. when required. The work week shall consist of a 40 hour week.

Moved by Clarence Bilson, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council call tenders for the following fence material which shall be more or less than the amounts listed: - 2,350 Rods of 8-42 wire fencing, 15-16 ft. wire gates, 1,560-7 ft. steel posts, 180-8 ft cedar anchor posts, minimum tops 8" to 10" peeled, 600-8 ft. cedar posts, minimum tops 6" peeled, 150-12 ft brace posts 4" tops peeled. Brace wire & staples. Tenders to be received on or before April 4th at 1.00 p.m.

March 9th 1972 meeting (Continued)

Moved by George Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrimage that Council call tenders for the supplying, crushing, hauling and spreading on Township roads of approximately 7,000 tons and 1000 tons off belt. Gravel to pass through a 5/8" screen, not more than 45% fines. Work to be completed on or before June 15th 1972.

Also, 7,000 tons of crushed gravel, more or less, same as above to be done at a later date. Contractor must strip all pits where necessary. Work to be done under the supervision of the Road Superintendent and to be subject to the approval of the Department of Transportation and Communications. Tenders to be received on or before April 4th 1972 at 1.00 p.m.

Meeting was then adjourned.
