

Foresters Falls, Ont. May 22d 1972

A special meeting called on this date to consider the application of Donald Thompson for a Tent & Trailer Park, the transfer of \$1000.00 bond to the general account, purchase of Hydro property and third reading to Drainage by-law.

Under by-law No. 1009 Ross Township Council granted a Tent & Trailer Camp licence to Donald Thompson on Lot 18, con. 2 in the Township of Ross. As it is Council's responsibility to grant a licence to these Trailer Parks each year we would like to lay down some guidelines for the operation of this camp.

(1) We would request the owner, Mr. Donald Thompson to control the size of all motor boats that are used by his campers and set a maximum size of 10 Horse Power.

(2) We would also request Mr. Thompson to use all good restraining judgment in the cutting of trees along the full length of his shore line defaced that he contact the Dept. of Lands & Forests and the local Council before proceeding.

(3) That Mr. Thompson agree to the foregoing agreements.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council transfer Victory Bond of \$1,000.00 to the Township General Account.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim give third reading to the Tile Drainage Borrowing By-law No. 994.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by G. Olmstead that Council purchase the Hydro property consisting of 46.8 acres being part of lot 27 Concession 5 in the Township of Ross for the price of \$700.00 and that, if a survey is necessary, that the Council will bear the cost of same and that the Council agree to give the Ontario Hydro and the cottagers permission to cross the corner of said property on the existing road.

The meeting was then adjourned
