Forester's Falls

April 18, 1973.

A special meeting was held on April 18, 1973 at 7:30 P.M. in the administration building to meet with Mr. Don Simpson, Real Estate Agent, from Pembroke. A discussion was held on the proposed sale of Chromasco Townsite and Mr. Simpson's proposal for the Municipality to take over (within the townsite boundaries) both the well and lake-water systems.

Mr. Simpson stated that it was estimated that it would cost the buyer \$100,000.00 to bring the 32 townsite houses up to acceptable standards. This included a new septic system, improving the water systems where necessary, painting the houses, and doing something to ~~the~~ make sure that there will be no more wet basements, etc.

Council suggested that shut-off valves would have to be installed on all water lines leading to the townsites from Chromasco and outside each home. The water lines should all be pressure tested and possibly all new lines installed in the old townsite.

Mr. Simpson stated that the houses ^{and land} would be divided up and surveyed into lots; and all road allowances are to be 66 feet. All conditions would have to meet the specifications of the OWRC and DCP.

The above is only a proposal which was presented by Mr. Don Simpson and discussed with council.

Council decided to make a tour of the Townsite on April 25, 1973.

Council decided to make a tour of the Township roads on Tuesday, April 24, 1973 starting at the Township garage at 10:00 AM.

Ray Dittbamer, representing the Fire Dept., stated that the "Kennewick County Mutual Aid Assoc." will be holding their annual meeting and luncheon in the L.O.L. #552 hall, Forester's Falls on April 24, 1973 at 8:00 P.M. Council agreed to pay \$1.40 per plate for approximately 60 plates.

Leo Rathwell stated that J. E. Gould asked if Council would give any assistance towards the purchasing of a new riding lawn mower for the Haley Cemetery? Request was tabled until the next regular meeting.

Alden May requested we write Bell Canada complaining about the present system in the Forester's Falls area and also request that they put in a heavier cable to Forester's Falls.

It was left to Alden May and Bill Stephens to get men to sweep the streets of Forester's Falls.

It was moved by J. Bell, seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pay the Kennewick County Board of Education the sum of (\$7,500.00) seven thousand & five hundred dollars on the 1972 Levy.

It was moved by J. Bell, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council accept with regret the resignation of W^m A. Stephens as Clerk-Treasurer of the Township.

It was moved by Barrie Ross, seconded by Ray Bennett that Council call tenders for the office of Clerk-Treasurer and Tax Collector for the Township of Ross. Applicants to be willing to take the Clerk-Treasurer's course if accepted, also to be bondable. Tenders to be in the hands of the Clerk-Treasurer by Tuesday May 8, 1973 at 12 o'clock noon.

It was moved by J. Bell, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council request a two
