

Forester's Falls, Ont. May 2, 1973.

The regular monthly meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held on May 2, 1973 with all members present.

The minutes of the April meetings were read and adopted by Council.

Alvin Stone explained to Council the proceedings of the proposed new "Colden and District Agriculture Community Centre".

It was moved by J. Bell, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council pay the Registration fee of \$60.00 for two members to attend the Annual Conference of Association of Municipalities of Ontario.

It was moved by Ray Bennett, seconded by Barrie Ross that Council accept the application of Henry Tabbert requesting money to be raised through debentures for drainage purposes on Lot 10 Con. 7 in the Twp. of Ross, County of Renfrew, in the amount of twenty-four hundred dollars (\$2,400.00) which is 75% of the total cost of the drain of which is estimated at \$3,220.00. To be given First and Second readings this 2nd day of May 1973.

It was moved by J. Bell, seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council pay Herb Ross the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) for services in January, auditors and other services.

It was moved by Barrie Ross, seconded by Ray Bennett that Council appoint Sam Crozier as Drainage Inspector for the year 1973 in the Township of Ross.

It was moved by J. Bell, seconded by Leo Rathwell that the Township of Ross become the purchaser of all properties on the Tax Sale list that do not bring the full price of taxes, interest and costs against such properties in the Township of Ross.

It was moved by Leo Rathwell, seconded by John Bell that Council accept and pay road voucher N^o 4 for the month of April in the amount of \$3,969.25.
