June 6, 1973

The regular meeting of the Ross Township Council was held on June 6, 1973 with all members present.

The minutes of the May meetings were read and adopted by council.

Mr. Claude Egnor, representative from the Waste Management Branch discussed closing the present dump and also the new site. He suggested that we ask for assistance in closing present site. Fencing, hauling garbage and informing the public of the operation of the new dump was discussed. A public meeting or a letter circulated before the new dump was opened was suggested.

Mr. Beattie Johnston requested that By-law no. 945 concerning mobile homes be enforced in the township.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council accept and pay Road Voucher # 5 for the month of May in the amount of \$2,917.65.

Moved by Carrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that council give a grant of twenty dollars (\$20.00) to Opportunities for Youth (Opportunities Renfrew County) for a survey of social services within the township.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Les Rathwell that council approve an expenditure of \$83.50 <sup>(eighty three dollars + fifty cents)</sup> per year to clean and repair the typewriter and calculator and put locks on box (11) set of drawers in the filing cabinet.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Les Rathwell that council approve the applications of Sydney David Campbell and Sidney D. Campbell requesting money to be raised through debentures for drainage purposes on Lot 5 1/2 15 Cor 6 - north east end and Lot 26, Cor 7 east-north portion in the Township of Ross, County of Renfrew.

Jack Bell brought it to the attention of council that the mound left at the Falls drain does not meet with the required max. of 10".

Ray Bennett reported on meetings he attended at Cobden re Cobden Rink. Main concern is raising money to get started, one suggestion was a raffle.
