Mr. Healy did not arrive but Council agreed to the following conditions: a new pressure tank,
 - a new pump and motor
 - to delete Proposed fire Hydrant in Green Gully report
 - to put in 17 shut-off valves on water line into houses at a cost reported by Don Simpson of \$2100.00 this \$2100.00 to be taken out of the \$4550.00 leaving a total of \$2450.00

Roads - Resurface and minor widening cost \$3750.00
 Total cost of work to be done by developer.

It was suggested that Council except the allotted money for fire hydrants instead of having the work done. The report on the well water for Light Alloy Townsite has not been received.

Council would like an agreement signed by Clarence for the use of water. Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that Council pay the county the remainder of 1973 being in meeting was adjourned. the amount of \$3,863.90.
