Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council grant application for tile drainage system loan to Edward Buraczewski in the total amount of \$814.20.

Moved by Carrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that Council appoint Clarkson & Gordon Accounts to do the audit of the Township of Ross for the year 1973.

Moved by Carrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that Council increase Mrs Allan Cole's salary to \$350.00 per year for 1973.

Council advised that the clerk see Mr. M^cNab about the legality of the signatures on the separate school notice of separate school suggestions.

Plans were made to attend the Good Roads Convention in Toronto at which Mr Cole will receive a long service award for 40 years or more service on roads.

By-law # 945 was discuss again. Council requested that Mr M^cNab add suggestions of council into the present by-law.

Three building permits were issued for the month of November to Mandy Bros, Henry Tubert and its Bulmer.

Correspondence was received to inform council that the fee for 1974 for V.N. Pembroke Branch will be raised to \$700.

The Deed for the Hydro property was received.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council pay L.O.L. # 552 the sum of \$75.00 Grant for the use of the hall.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council pay the Reeve Mr. Alden May the sum of \$2000.00 for remuneration and expenses for the year 1973.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that council pay the deputy reeve \$150⁰⁰ more than normal salary.

A ratemanager was present to suggest signs be posted at the present dump site to prohibit non-residents from using the dump.
