Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rathwell that the clerk write to Bell Canada with a copy to Clarence Gauthier requesting more cables to Forester's Falls for private and semi-private lines for business and other persons requesting this service.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council pay L.O.L. # 552 the sum of \$75.00 Grant for the use of the hall.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council pay the Reeve Mr. Alden May the sum of \$2000.00 for remuneration and expenses for the year 1973.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that council pay the deputy reeve \$150<sup>00</sup> more than normal salary.

A ratemanager was present to suggest signs be posted at the present dump site to prohibit non-residents from using the dump.
