A special meeting of council was called on December 18, 1973 to meet with Mr. Healey and Mr. Simpson also with the Road Employees.

Mr. Healey was undecided what to do about the wash tank water as the Health Unit did not mention it to him.

On the agenda to the road the developer needs to replace the control that lets the air into the tank in required amounts.

The road must be decided to the municipality. Any cost of the pump house should be charged to the property owners. The Light Alley Inn site is completed but not hooked up.

Before the date ^{could be set} for the Township to take over the roads and water council will consult with their solicitor for final legal arrangements including a performance bond.

Council asked that Mr. Healey mark fire hydrants and cutoff valves for snowplowing. Pump house not surveyed.

Mr. Healey plans to change names of streets also transfer his rights on water from the lake to the municipality. Township will do the plowing of the roads at the Inn site.
