January 24/74

A special meeting of Council was held on January 24th 1974 to meet with Mr. Clarence Gauthier, representative from Bell Canada.

Mr. Gauthier's main reason for poor service in the Township was due to the slow growth of the population. If give free toll charge to Pembroke or Renfrew the monthly flat rate would be greatly increased. The Clerk was instructed to write a letter explaining Council's dissatisfaction with the present service and request a firm commitment in writing before the end of 1974 for a definite date of more lines into the Forester's Falls district.

Ray Dittmer was present concerning a grant for the Athletic Association in Forester's Falls.

Council reviewed specs for a 5 ton truck, 2 way spreader V Plow, snow plow & harness & wing.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rothwell that Council call for tenders on a five ton truck, with two way spreader, V plow, wing and harness. Yellow top coat of paint that complies with MTC Standard ES 301 on body of truck and sanded.

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council
 was held on February 6, 1974 with all members present.

Minutes of the January meeting were read and adopted
 by Council.

It was moved by Les Rathwell seconded by John Bell that
 Council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 1 for the month of January
 in the amount of \$4,692.17.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that Council
 give a grant of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to the Queen's Line
 Athletic Assoc, Ross Township Valley Athletic Assoc. and Ross
 Township Community Centre for recreation.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that Council
 approve the paying membership fee of \$5.00 to Ontario Association
 of Fire Chiefs for the year 1974.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Les Rathwell address
 clause 1 of Section 354 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284
 permits councils of all municipalities to pass by-laws for restricting
 the number of animals that may be kept by any person within the
 municipality or a defined area thereof.

Now therefore be it enacted and it is hereby enacted
 by the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross as follows.

1. That no occupant or occupants of any premises or self
 contained establishment shall harbour or keep more than two
 dogs for each such premises or establishment.

2. Every person who contravenes this by-law shall be liable
 to a fine of not more than \$100.00 exclusive of cost and, or
 imprisonment for a term of not more than twenty one days.
