Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rathwell that council pass by-law no. 1053 for the purpose of refunding taxes in the amount of \$290.67.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass by-law no. 1054 for the purpose of writing off uncollected dog tax in the amount of \$50.00.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass by-law no. 1055 for the purpose of writing off taxes in the amount of \$641.49.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that Council pass a motion to accept Donahue Motors Ltd. tender on 5 ton truck equipped with 9' snowplough and wing and a Frink of Canada Two-way grader. Being a by-law to provide for a drainage works in the Township of Ross and for borrowing on the credit of the Municipality the sum of \$15,140.00 for completing the drainage works. The by-law to be known as the "5th Line Municipal Drain By-Law".

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rathwell that Council call tender for caretaker of the Waste Disposal Site, tender to include picking up and/or covering garbage once a week. Tender to be in the Municipal Office March 26, 1974 @ 12 noon. Particulars may be picked up at the office.
