The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council met on June 5, 1974 with all members present.

The minutes of the May meetings were read and adopted by council.

Percy Mc Gregor got the consent of council to start a private garbage collection in the Township.

\* Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by John Bell that council accept Ministry of Transportation recommendation on W.P. 767-01 Township road between Hwy 653 and Jones Line road, all except last half of clause b which we would like to see widened another 8 ft on each side of culvert and road bed over culvert.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rathwell that council give this reading and pass by-law # 1057 to provide for a drainage works in the Township of Ross in the County of Renfrew and for borrowing on the credit of the municipality the sum of \$3,354.00 for completing the drainage works.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council pay road voucher # 5 in the amount of \$5,771.14 for the month of May, 1974.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass a by-law prohibiting spreading garbage on township roads/ways and persons found doing so may be fined up to fifty dollars (\$50.00) also on Township property.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council accept the application of Marnel Hill requesting money to be raised through debentures for drainage purposes in the amount of \$3900.00 and that council pass rating by-law for this purpose.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council accept the application of Sidney D. Campbell and David Sydney Campbell requesting money to be raised through debentures for drainage purposes in the amount of \$2000.00 and \$3100.00 respectfully and that Council pass rating by-law for this purpose.

Moved by Leo Rathwell seconded by John Bell that council pass by-law # 1020 to allow mobile homes on building lots in the Municipality of Ross. By-law # 1020 to come under By-law # 905 which requires a building permit. By-law given first second and third readings and passed.
