Ross Municipal reconvened on June 11, 1974 to deal with business left over from the meeting held June 5, 1974 and all members were present.

Moved by Leo Rathwell and seconded by Jack Bell that the wage rate for the firemen for the year 1974 be adjusted as follows:

Week end duty	-	\$20.00
Long week-end duty	-	30.00
First call up to 2 hrs	-	10.00
Hourly rate after 2 hrs	-	5.00 per hour
Fire Chief	-	\$400.00 per year
Deputy Fire Chief	-	300.00 per year

Moved by Kay Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that Council give the Waste Disposal Site, by-law # 1063 the third and final reading.

Council was advised that a dog ^{+ cat} clinic will be held in the Forester's Falls Fire Hall on July 27th, 1974 from 2 to 4 P.M.

Council requested that Calvin McLaughlin, dog tax collector, begin work on the 15th of June and work to be completed by September 1, 1974. Horses are included as a dog.

Meeting was adjourned.

June 18, 1974

A special meeting of council was held on June 19, 1974 as a Court of Revision. The council acted as the Court of Revision for the meeting.

One appeal was heard.

The Engineer advised that the material may be used on the road. He estimated that 1100 yds of material could be used as well as 5300 yds outside the slopes. No material would have to be drawn away. It was suggested that it would go to tender if earth had to be taken away. Township is to strip top soil and payment to be made to them on tender price. Cost of trucking etc. to be charged to the drain. The Court agreed that if material had to be moved that the Township should not be charged.

Also the Court agreed that a fence in Hawthorne's field is the responsibility of the farmer.

Township is to do all the fencing on the road.

The Engineer offered to send me ^{separate} information on the strip quantities.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that Council request Goldwood Development Ltd. Re: Chromasco and Leght Alloys Tonnages, to resurface roads adjacent to Lots # 1 to 5 and Lots # 6 to 20. also put in 18" C.S.P. past Lot # 5. The road to be given a lift of 6" crushed gravel from Lots # 1 to 5.

After a letter was read from M.T.C. it was suggested that Allan Cole get measurements and prices for a link-chain fence to be created at the Township garage.

After some discussion it was decided that no extra keys would be given out for the gate at the new waste disposal site.

Meeting was adjourned.

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council met on July 3rd, 1974 with all members present.

The minutes of the June meetings were read and adopted by Council.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that ^{Council pay} road voucher # 6 in the amount of \$6,595.03 for the month of June 1974.

The Road Superintendent reported that the spraying of weeds along the township roadways was underway.

After some discussion with two ratepayers concerning a Municipal Drain they were advised that another Court of Revision will be held after the reading of the report.

Norman Byre verified the tile drainage work done in the township for his tile drainage loan.

Another ratepayer inquired into leasing land to install a mobile home. Council had no objection to this but he must comply with By-laws # 905, 945 and 1070.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rattwell that Council grant Percy Mc Giegar a key to the Waste Disposal Site, for the purpose of disposing garbage after a garbage pick-up.

A Rabie clinic is to held in Forester's Falls Fire Hall on July 29, 1974 for all cats and dogs.

Council consented to Mrs. Bell, librarian taking one week holidays.
