The road to be given a lift of 6" crushed gravel from Lots # 1 to 5.

After a letter was read from M.T.C. it was suggested that Allan Cole get measurements and prices for a link-chain fence to be created at the Township garage.

After some discussion it was decided that no extra keys would be given out for the gate at the new waste disposal site.

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council met on July 3rd, 1974 with all members present.

The minutes of the June meetings were read and adopted by Council.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that ^{Council pay} road voucher # 6 in the amount of \$6,595.03 for the month of June 1974.

The Road Superintendent reported that the spraying of weeds along the township roadway was underway.

After some discussion with two ratepayers concerning a Municipal Drain they were advised that another Court of Revision will be held after the reading of the report.

Norman Byre verified the tile drainage work done in the township for his tile drainage loan.

Another ratepayer inquired into leasing land to install a mobile home. Council had no objection to this but he must comply with By-laws # 905, 945 and 1070.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Leo Rattwell that Council grant Percy Mc Giegar a key to the Waste Disposal Site, for the purpose of disposing garbage after a garbage pick-up.

A Rabie clinic is to held in Forester's Falls Fire Hall on July 29, 1974 for all cats and dogs.

Council consented to Mrs. Bell, librarian taking one week holidays.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that council endorse the resolution from the Township of Pittsburgh pertaining to the amendment to the present legislation of increasing the penalty for the non payment of taxes to a maximum of 2% per month for each calendar month in which default continues.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council grant application for tile drainage loan to Alder May in the amount of ^{estimated} \$785.00.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Ray Bennett that council set the following mill rate for the year 1974.

General - Residential - 28.3

Commercial - 34.2

County - Residential - 18.8

Commercial - 18.8

Public School Residential - 25.9

Commercial 28.7

High School Residential 19.5

Commercial 21.7

Street Lights - 7.0

Also that taxes shall become due and payable on the 12th day of August, 1974 but may be paid in two instalments namely 12th day of August 1974 and the 12th day of December 1974

There shall be a 3% discount on the second instalment if paid on or before August 12th, 1974

No definite answer will be given to the Village of Cobden who have requested to use the township waste disposal site.
