Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that council endorse the resolution from the Township of Pittsburgh pertaining to the amendment to the present legislation of increasing the penalty for the non payment of taxes to a maximum of 2% per month for each calendar month in which default continues.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council grant application for tile drainage loan to Alder May in the amount of ^{estimated} \$785.00.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Ray Bennett that council set the following mill rate for the year 1974.

General - Residential - 28.3

Commercial - 34.2

County - Residential - 18.8

Commercial - 18.8

Public School Residential - 25.9

Commercial - 28.7

High School Residential - 19.5

Commercial - 21.7

Street Lights - 7.0

Also that taxes shall become due and payable on the 12th day of August, 1974 but may be paid in two instalments namely 12th day of August 1974 and the 12th day of December 1974.

There shall be a 3% discount on the second instalment if paid on or before August 12th, 1974.
