Council passed by-law #1074 being a by-law to borrow money under the 5th Drainage Act. 1971.

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on October 2, 1974 with all members present.

Moved by Les Rathwell seconded by Jack Bell that council give 2 readings to by-law #1075 being a subdivision by-law to restrict the use of land on Plan No. [unclear] according to the draft (attached hereto) and that the by-law then be submitted to Ontario Municipal Board with request for its approval.

Jack Bell reported that ^{some} work had been completed on the Forester's Falls Municipal Drain.

Les Rathwell reported that the work on the Halcy Municipal Drain has not finished.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council pay road voucher #9 in the amount of \$21,305.80 for the month of September 1974.
