Casual Labour - \$3.66 per hr.

Labour - \$3.96 per hr.

Tractor, Truck, Grader Operator \$4.16 per hr.

Grader Operator \$4.26 per hr. from April 1st to Oct 31st.

Assistance rd. foreman 10¢ per hr. extra when required
