The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on March 5, 1975 in the Council chambers with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted by council and the bills were presented.

A delegate presented a petition to have the cattle in the Township sprayed for warble flies. After some discussion council agreed to make this service available to interested farmers.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay road voucher no. 2 in the amount of \$4,739.34 for the month of February 1975.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council introduce by-law #19-75 being a by-law to amend by-law #1070 clause 2 to include a Mobile Home on which the running gear is removed, as a building within the meaning of section 3 thereof.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council introduce By-law #20-75 being a by-law to collect a licence fee from Mobile Home owners presently situated in the Township. That a Mobile Home now used for living, sleeping or eating accommodation be charged a licence fee of Ten dollars (\$10.00) for every month or portion thereof, that the said Mobile Home is located in the municipality, payable in advance to the By-law Enforcement Officer. Also that By-Law #945 section 3.11 Licence fees shall be in accordance with the following schedule, and that subsection 3.11.2 be amended as follows:

3.11.2 To occupy a Mobile Home trailer camp \$10.00 per calendar month payable in advance on the first day of each month for every lot which is occupied for more than 10 days during a month. By-law #17-75 is hereby rescinded.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Township of Ross Council approve the Road Superintendent's proposed Expenditures for road improvements for the year 1975.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council give a grant of \$300.00 to Forester's Falls Community Centre and Queen's Line Athletic Assoc. for the year 1975.

Mr. Battist from the Renfrew County Board of Education was present inquiring about the 1974 arrears of taxes.

Council agreed to let the trees along the road be used for winter wood at the risk of permission is granted by the property owner first.

Council agreed to have Mr. Bert Ross removed from the fence viewers.

The Council advised that an advertisement be placed in the papers notifying the ratepayers that a fire permit must be obtained before setting a fire between April 1, 1975 and October 31, 1975.
