March 18, 1975.

A special meeting of council was held on March 18, 1975 with all councillors present.

Moved by Jack Bell second by Bernie Ross that taxes in the amount of \$67.17 be refunded as provided by section 636 subsection 1 and section 636.9 subsection 1 of the Municipal Act.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that council engage Keith Bennett for the purpose of spraying cattle for Warble Fly Control at the rate of \$15.00 per lb. for the 1975 season. His duties would include:

- (1) Supply tractor for hauling sprayer (if required)
- (2) If possible two (2) men besides himself to operate sprayer.
- (3) Organize and schedule sprayer visits.
- (4) Oversee the mixing of solution and spraying of cattle.
- (5) Count all cattle sprayed.
- (6) Collect spraying fee of 40¢ per head of cattle sprayed.
- (7) Attend a spraying school for Warble Fly Control.
(Himself and if possible one other man).

It was the decision of council that the building at the ball diamond be insured with Mr. Barron but charged back to the Athletic Association.

Meeting was adjourned.
