Mr. Biggs gave a demonstration of a electrostatic machine. It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Ray Bennett that council purchase an Electrostatic Copier from Donald F. Runge for \$595.00 plus tax of \$29.75.

A complaint was heard from a ratepayer concerning the smoke from burning at the waste disposal site.

Keith Bennett reported on the cattle sprayed for warble fly. There were 3246 head which were sprayed @ 40¢ per head.

Ted Basso presented on insurance premiums and explained the coverage.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council accept the tender of Ken Mergler for crushed gravel & Stock Pile of 3/8" crushed for the year 1975.
