A special meeting of Council was held on May 22, 1975 to discuss the water systems at the tourists.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council accept the Engineer's report and drawings concerning the grey water look-ups to service any future lots to be sold at Chomasco Tourist sites, requesting water service from the Township owned main water line.

It was suggested that the Ministry of Environment be informed of the pollution left after the train derailment at Haley's.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council accept the applications of Gary Scott and James Bennett requesting moneys to be raised through debentures for drainage purposes in the amount of \$3800.00 and \$1800.00 respectively and Council pass a by-law for this purpose.

June 4, 1975

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on June 4, 1975 with all members present.

The minutes of the May meetings were read and adopted by Council. The bills were presented.

A ratepayer inquired about opening the road allowance between Lot 6, Cor 3 and Lot 1, Cor 1. E. M. D. Council consented to consider this next year.

A letter requesting an additional grant was received from the Forester's Falls Athletic Association. After some discussion the grant was refused as the year's budget has been approved by Council.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of fencing along a Township road.

Whereas it is deemed necessary to erect a fence the property owner shall contact the Road Superintendent and if he approves a new fence be erected, he shall stake fence line 33' from the centre road line. Property owner shall build the fence, using 8 strands 42" wire and when completed, including the old fence removed, he shall present the Clerk with a bill for the total cost of the wire. With the Road Superintendent's approval Council shall pay half the cost of the wire only.

Therefore, the Council of the Township of Ross, with Road Superintendent's approval shall pay one-half the cost of wire used to fence along a Township road.

June 4/74

Council consented to offer the hay at the waste disposal site to Eric Gibson for 30¢ a bale.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council agree to pay to the Renfrew County Agricultural Veterinary Unit the sum of \$360.85 for the year 1973.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pass a by-law to regulate transient traders.

A licence fee of \$300.00 shall be obtained before a business is opened.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council appoint Sam Crozier as Drainage Inspector for the year 1974.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay C.A. (Ted) Barrow the sum of \$2102.73 for Township Insurance.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pass a resolution allowing the encroachment up at the road allowance between Lots 10 and 11 presently owned by Staffed Millar.

And whereas that part of the road allowance occupied by the said buildings is not required by the Township for road purposes.

Now therefore, the Corporation of the Township of Ross shall not be responsible for any damage caused to the buildings, however the same be caused. Also, the owner shall be responsible for all claims for third parties that could or may be made against the municipality with respect to its liability to keep and maintain the highway in a safe condition.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council set charges for the use of office copiers with work to be done at a time convenient to the Clerk.

25¢ per copy for less than 100 copies.

\$20.00 per hundred copies for 100 or more copies.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay Road Voucher No. 5 in the amount of \$11,876.82 for the month of May.

 council to attend a Mutual Fire Aid meeting on June 23rd in the
 Council Chambers.

It was moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Alvin Stone that

 the township street, providing there is proper amount of fall for
 good drainage, and drain is continued to County Road #7 and,
 whereas, permission is obtained by Mr Healey from the County for
