

Forester's Falls, Ont.

July 2, 1975

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held in the council chamber on July 2, 1975 with all members present.

The minutes of the June meetings were read and approved by council.

The bills were presented for the drainage account, water account and general account.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Bernie Ross that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of refunding taxes in the amount of \$10510 as recommended by the Clerk-Treasurer as provided by Section 636A, subsection 1 of the Municipal Act. Refund to be applied to 1973 outstanding taxes.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council grant permission for application for loans on tile drainage from Osborne Bennett and David Sidney Campbell for \$2600.00 and \$3700.00 respectively.

A complaint was heard from Mr. Hugh McLaughlin concerning the Haley Drain. Council consented to look at the situation before making a decision.

Calvin McLaughlin reported that 246 bags had been tugged to date.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Bernie Ross that pay road vouchers No. 6 in the amount of \$7,466.19 for the month of June.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council pass a resolution requesting Department of Transportation and Communications to have the Township road known as the Garden of Eden Road, Lots 23-27, Cor. 3 to have a layer of crushed gravel put on when construction finishes using it as access road to 417 which is being constructed at the present time by Amber Construction.

It was a request of council that Ontario Hydro be notified that that shoreline at Garden Lake is being used as a week-end campsite.

Alvin Stone and Jack Bell were appointed to measure the sidewalks requiring repair in the village of Forester's Falls.

July 16, 1975

A special meeting of council was held on July 16, 1975 to discuss water rates at the Townsite.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council amend by-law #1078 and set the water rates for the subdivision known as Goldwoods Development in Lot 25 Con 5 as follows:

\$7.00 per month for each occupied lot.
 2.00 per month for each vacant lot.

Billing to be three times a year, with a penalty clause of 1% after due date. Water will be cut off after 30 days default.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that council authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to bill the residents of Goldwoods Townsite for water purposes at four month intervals with Council's consent to bill for the last five (5) months of the 1975, to end the year on Dec 31, 1975

It was the decision of council to construct or reconstruct 461 ft of sidewalk in Forester's Falls.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that ~~the Township Fire Trucks be used for fighting fires only unless called out to Emergencies by Law Enforcing Officers.~~

It was moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Jack Bell that council agree to grant to Harvey Pilgrim Jr. Lot 25, Con 6 a loan for tile drainage in the amount of \$2500.00 work to be completed about July 18, 1975.

A final settlement was discuss to close the old dump site at John McMaster's.
