A special meeting of council was held on July 28, 1975 to discuss repairs to the Black Drain.

A representative from Green, Holloway & Associates, Harry Stotson, was present to discuss the legal procedure as pointed in the report. After some discussion Mr. Stotson decided to report back to his company before a decision could be made as it was suggested that a rip-rap had been put at the end of the drain <sup>at the</sup> <sup>of the</sup> <sup>drain</sup> <sup>surgically</sup>.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the Township Fire Truck be used for fighting fires only. Unless called out to emergencies by law-enforcing officers.

Council agreed to bill Reg. Humphreys \$30 for the use of the fire truck.

A letter was sent to John McMaster making suggestions for a settlement.

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on August 6, 1975 in the Council Chamber with all members present.

The minutes of the July meetings were read and adopted by council.

Council appointed Jack Bell to purchase Prestone for the fire hydrants at the Goldwoods Inn.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council accept the tender of L. W. Wright to supply, load and haul Pit Run gravel from Burwell's Pitt. To be delivered on the Town Line between Ross and Westmeath Townships @ 98¢ per cubic yard.

Allan Cole advised council that hot mix would be used to fix the manholes in Forester's Falls.

After hearing a letter read from Green, Holloway & Associates it was council's decision to abide by the engineer's recommendation on repairs to the farm ponds in the Stanley Black Municipal Drain. The decision of the engineer being that the land owner must make all repairs to the farm ponds.

The meeting <sup>in order Sept 9th</sup> to discuss the Restructuring of Lennox County was discussed and it was decided to send a representative from council to this meeting.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road voucher # 7 with the amount of \$29,305.82 for the month of July.
