The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on September 3, 1975 with all members present.

The minutes of the August meetings were read and adopted by council.

Correspondence was read and included a letter from the Ministry of Transportation & Communications requesting names for Township Roads onto Highway 17 and 653. Also approval to lower the speed limit near Haley's to 50 m.p.h.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pass a resolution authorizing the Ministry of Transportation and Communications to reduce the speed limit west of Haley's on old Highway 17 to 50 miles per hour.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Store that council pay road voucher No 8 in the amount of \$13,520.35 for the month of August 1975.

It was moved by Alvin Store seconded by Ray Bennett that the attached list of uncollectable taxes in the amount of \$399.66 be written off the tax roll as provided by section 636 subsection 1 and section 636A subsection 1 of the Municipal Act.
