October 1, 1975

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on October 1, 1975 in the council chambers with all members present.

The minutes of the September meetings were read and adopted by council, the bills were presented.

Council agreed to give a key for the waste disposal site to a private garbage collector.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alden Stow that council pay road voucher No. 9 in the amount of \$30,329.79 for the month of September 1975.

It was moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Jack Bell that council purchase 440 Gallon Tanks from E. Brown, Beachburg for the Light Alloy Tour site, to be delivered to the tour site in 6 to 8 weeks.

Council agreed to pay the Green, Galloway Assoc. bill for their services, concerning the ponds at the Stanley Black Drain, out of the General Account.

A letter was received from the Ministry of Transportation and Communications acknowledging our request for a Development Road on the 4th line. However this has not been followed up to date.

A letter was received from John M^r Master accepting council offer to a final closing of the old dump site. The offer being a refund of \$263.56 for back taxes, @ 20 rods of wire and posts supplied by the township, and additional 5 rods if available for the road superintendent @ \$200 for his labour. Fence to be built to the Road Superintendent's satisfaction.

A brief is being prepared on Restructuring Repeal County to be presented to the Study Commission, Eric Hardy.

A special meeting of council was held on October 6, 1975 to complete the brief to restructuring Renfrew County to be presented at a hearing in Renfrew.

A letter was read from the Renfrew County Beef Improvement Association requesting council to pay 25% of cost to have cattle sprayed in the Township. After a discussion it was decided not to support this program.

Also a letter was received from the Ministry of Transportation and Communications advising that the Stone Line is being accepted as a Development Road. Bromley Township Council have accepted all responsibility of the work to be done. It was moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass a by-law to authorize the execution of an agreement with the ^{Ont.} Ministry of Transportation and Communications relating to a road under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Ross. Designated as Development road Number 1247.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass a by-law to accept Grew, Galloway + Associates Ltd Engineering study, dated May 16, 1975 as to water service for Lot 7. That owner of Lot 7 supply material and do excavating, plumbing, boring, jacking and pay \$50.00 to waterworks account to look into the waterline. Work to be supervised by Maintenance Superintendent Homer Hamilton.

It was moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass a by-law #44-758 for the purpose of increasing the clerk's term salary for of Jan 1, 1976 by one thousand dollars for the year 1976.
