The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on December 3rd, 1975 in the Council Chambers with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read and adopted by council and the bills were presented.

Mr. Herb Ross, retired Clerk-Treasurer, was honoured by council when he was presented with his picture which was hung in the Council Chambers.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Store that the Council of the Township of Ross pay Road Voucher No. 11 in the amount of \$8456.07 for the month of November 1975.

It was moved by Barrie Ross seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross pass, and give a third reading, short and pass by Law No. 47-75 being a by-law to regulate the installation of entrance ways.

It was moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the Council of the Township of Ross give three readings and pass by-law No. 48-75 being a by-law to regulate and control the use of untravelled portions of township roads. Subject to the approval of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

It was moved by Alvin Store seconded by Ray Bennett that council accept the tender of Gulf Oil Canada Ltd. (Alton Harris, Agent) to supply Furnace and Stove Oil to Ross Township Service and Maintenance buildings for the year 1976.

Fire Chief, Roy Dittlmer, was present and gave a fire report.

It was moved by Alvin Store seconded by Ray Bennett that the attached list of uncollectable taxes in the amount of \$65 be written off the tax roll as provided by section 636, subsection 1 and section 636A subsection 1 of the Municipal Act.
