By-Law for appointing Municipal Officers was given first, second and third readings and finally passed this 12th day of January 1976.

It was moved by Alvin Store seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross engage Hillier & Lyer to clean and sand the streets in Forester's Falls for the year 1976, when and where necessary at the rate of \$7.50 per cu.

Also that Clifford M<sup>r</sup> Laughlin keep the entrance to the Haley Fire truck clear, when and where necessary at the rate of \$7.50 per cu.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pass a by-law to reimburse members of council for meetings attended and expenses for the year 1976 as follows:

Attending Council Meetings \$28.00 per meeting.

Travelling Expenses \$224.00 per year.

Deputy-Reeve will be paid \$168.00 per year.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council pay 18¢ per mile for Township employees and officials on council business.

It was moved by Alvin Store seconded by Ray Bennett that council forward the Queen's Line Athletic Association a grant for the sum of \$300.00 for the purpose of defraying Operating costs of their outdoor skating rink for the year 1976.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the council of the Township of Ross engage the Cobden Sun to do the Municipal printing for the year 1976.

It was moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the council of the Township of Ross make application to the Bank of Nova Scotia at Cobden to borrow money to meet the expenditures for the year 1976 so they become due and to authorize the Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer to borrow money for this purpose not to exceed the amount of \$5,000.00.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Store that the council of the Township of Ross pass a by-law authorizing the paying of all acceptable bills and accounts for the year 1976.

It was moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the council of the Township of Ross pass a by-law authorizing the Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer to sign all necessary documents for the year 1976.
